2. PROJECT DESCRIPTION.

3. METHODS.

Study area: Where do you plan to implement your project, please include a very brief description of your study area (100 words maximum).

Sampling design: Briefly describe the strategy you will use to conduct your research and the different approaches e.g.: field observation, experimentation, interview surveys, etc.)

Data collection: Briefly describe how you will collect your data; include sample sizes, target population, variables to measure and how they will be measured (300 words maximum).

Start date: When do you expect to start your internship with AMMCO?

Budget: What is the total amount of your project? How much have you secured so far? How do plan to seek for the remaining funding? (150 words maximum).

References: Please include here any literature references you have used in your project proposal.
