This is an opportunity to demonstrate your skills and experience to help solve complex problems and have a direct and highly visible impact on planet Earth.

You will leverage Agile methodology under the supervision of one of our engineering managers and in partnership with our UI/UX team to implement, test and deploy specific new features and use cases required by our partners for our Flutter-based SIREN mobile application on iOS and Android.

MAJOR RESPONSIBILITIES

- Add tracking of more marine species.
- Integrate the use of machine learning for species identification.
- Global availability of animal observations to a fleet of mobile devices.
- Add the support for more languages.
- Help optimize the performances of the application like the GPS/location accuracy and data sync under poor cell reception.
